# BYLAW CHANGES

At the May 31, 2011, board meeting, these bylaw changes were recommended and approved by the board. At the September 27 meeting, these changes will be recommended for the membership to approve by vote. Please read and be prepared to vote.

**Article III Section 8: Membership** – To be eligible for membership in the club, a prospective member must attend 3 consecutive general meetings from September through May and then submit 3 letters of recommendation with at least 1 letter being from a current club member to the executive board. After the executive board has favorably passed on the applicant by open ballot, an invitation shall be sent to them by the secretary. Said invitation shall be a form letter stating the purpose of the club as set out in Article II of the bylaws and calling attention to the duties of membership as defined in Article III.

**Article IV Section 1: Dues** – Dues for regular members would be \$30 per year, for associate members \$40 per year and \$50 for any new member joining for the first time. Annual dues are payable in February.
